LONG TERM PERMISSION REQUEST FORM

When your student's physician determines it is necessary to administer medication during the school day, the following procedures need to occur:

1. A parent/guardian or responsible adult designee must bring the medication to school and give to school nurse.
2. All medication must be in the **PRESCRIPTION/ORIGINAL CONTAINER** clearly labeled with the student's name, the name and dose of medication, directions for administration and date, pharmacy and physician name.
3. A physician must complete long-term permission request form each school year, as well as when there is a medication change. Prescribing physicians have to have a license to practice in the state of Texas, unless they are military physicians.
4. Only FDA approved pharmaceuticals manufactured in the United States may be administered. **HOMEOPATHIC PREPARATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
5. Medications will not be sent home with students. A parent/guardian or adult designee must pick up all medications.
6. Medication ordered two times a day can be given at home before school and when the child returns home from school.
