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Vision/Hearing

Who: State requires PreK, K, 1st, 3rd, 5th and 7th but in our district we check all 4 years and older in all our elementary schools, 7th grade students in middle schools and all new students that enroll in middle school and high school.

When: Within 120 days of admission (in our school district we attempt to have all students screened by the end of September and then we screen all new students as they enroll in our district)

Scoliosis

Spinal screening is designed to detect unnatural curvatures of the spine.

Who: Girls will be screened two times once in the 5th grade and then again in the 7th grade (Age 10 and 12). Boys will be screened one time in the 8th grade (Age 13).

When: Spinal screenings will take place the first half of the year and will continue with new students that require screenings.

Type 2 Diabetes (Acanthosis Nigricans)

Acanthosis Nigricans (AN) is a skin discoloration that may indicate high levels of insulin in the blood, which results from insulin resistance.

Insulin resistance can create a potential risk for the development of Type 2 Diabetes

When: At the Time of the Vision and Hearing Test, throughout the school year.

Who: 1st, 3rd, 5th and 7th grades
